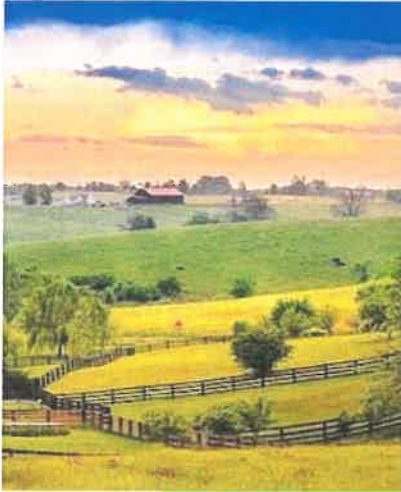

Tonight is the tour highlight as we board **My Old Kentucky Dinner Train** for an upscale dining experience as we view the picturesque scenery from historic, renovated Pullman coach cars.

Day 4 - Lexington, Kentucky is en route home and what better way to conclude our tour visiting a **Kentucky Horse Farm**. Magnificent horse farms dot the landscape in the rolling hills.
