Sample Itinerary:

Day 1 - Travel to upstate New York.

Day 2 - Continental breakfast. Continue into Vermont enjoying the spectacular fall colors. This afternoon board the Green Mountain Flyer and go back to the days when train travel was the only way to go. Built in the 1850's, these lines still serve the Green Mountain Railroad and Amtrak. Climb aboard and take a scenic journey through the picturesque southern Vermont countryside in restored coaches pulled by a vintage diesel locomotive. Travel along the Connecticut and Williams Rivers with spectacular views of Brockway Mills Gorge and two historic covered bridges. Arrive in White River Junction for our overnight with incredible, panoramic views of the countryside.

Day 3 - Stop at Quechee Gorge, "Vermont's Little Grand Canyon" for some beautiful fall vistas. Witness the dazzling fall colors as we cross from Vermont into New Hampshire. Take the Cannon Mountain Aerial Tram to the 4000 foot summit of Cannon Mountain. On a clear day you can see the mountains of four states and Canada! Lodging for (3) nights Best Western White Mountains in Franconia, New Hampshire. Guest rooms are tastefully appointed and the lovely White Mountains provide a scenic backdrop dinner included at a local restaurant.

Day 4 - A day trip to stunning Lake Winnepesaukee combines a scenic rail excursion with a delightful afternoon boat cruise. Board the Winnepesaukee Scenic Railroad for an unsurpassed look at the lakeside scenery along the shores of Lake Winnepesaukee. The fabulous New Hampshire fall colors surround us on this excursion. This afternoon board the MS Mount Washington for a two hour scenic cruise on New Hampshire's largest lake. Autumn is a special time in the Lakes Region and travelers come from hundreds of miles to enjoy the splendor of New Hampshire's foliage. Late afternoon return to our hotel. Dinner included.

Day 5 - Prepare for a thrilling morning aboard the Mount Washington Cog Railway, the world's first mountain climbing Cog Railway. The ever-changing surroundings, the magnificent views, the sights and sounds of unique steam locomotives in actions, and some of the steepest railway tracks in existence, combine to place it among the best of the world's great railway journeys. Some days the view from the summit spans four states, Quebec and the Atlantic Ocean, limited only by the curvature of the earth. Other days you literally climb above the clouds. Join us for a fascinating journey and truly an unforgettable rail excursion. Make a brief stop in the village of Littleton and visit Chutters, home of the World's Longest Candy Counter. A special evening is planned on the Cafe Lafayette Dinner Train as we invite you to escape the ordinary and relive the romance of dining on the rails. Experience a five course dinner served to you in the Grand European manner while riding in beautifully restored Pullman dining cars. With magnificent mountain vistas and lush New England forests, you are assured of a 5-star experience.

Day 6 Travel to the beautiful Finger Lakes Region in Upstate New York. Named for the linear finger-shaped lakes that were formed during the Ice Ages, the Finger Lakes Region boasts a topography that's reminiscent of the Tuscany Region in Italy—Where picturesque towns, fresh-fare restaurants, and vineyards dot the rolling hills and overlook deep blue lakeshores. Lodging for two nights in Canandaigua, NY

Day 7—This is a change from the original brochure and may be more appealing. Visit and tour Sonnenberg Mansion & Gardens, one of the most treasured landmarks of the region (www.sonnenberg.org) Mid-day enjoy some leisure time in the lovely village of Canandaigua.
