Dow Gardens & The Longest Canopy Walk Featuring: Marshall M. Fredericks Sculpture Museum Wednesday, June 17th, 2026



Dow Gardens & Longest Canopy Walk -

Discover acres of identified trees, shrubs, herbaceous perennials, and flowers. Dow Gardens was established in 1899 by Herbert H. Dow for the enjoyment of his family, friends, and associates. Since then, the gardens have delighted hundreds of thousands of visitors from all over the world. The Dow Gardens is owned and operated by The Herbert H. and Grace A. Dow Foundation.

Stretching just over a quarter of a mile long throughout Whiting Forest, the canopy walk splits off in three directions, each offering a different overlook experience and scenery. The canopy walk is the longest in the country.



This permanent exhibit features over 200 of Fredericks's works, including plaster models, sketches, and site models. Highlights include a 28-foot-tall statue of Christ on the south wall and models of well-known works like The Spirit of Detroit. An outdoor garden adjacent to the museum features over 20 bronze sculptures by Fredericks. You can also see a fountain and seating areas. The Sculptor's Studio is a permanent installation that recreates Fredericks's studio, displaying his original tools, equipment, and items to illustrate his creative process. The museum hosts rotating exhibitions featuring the work of other artists from the region and around the world.
