

SUNRISE SIDE LIGHTHOUSE TOUR

Join us as we head to Michigan's Sunrise Side and two of the State's most treasured and historic Lighthouses. Our first stop is Sturgeon Point Lighthouse. It's a historic 70-foot-9-inch brick tower on Lake Huron in Harrisville, Michigan, completed in 1870 to warn ships of a dangerous 1.5-mile reef. It features an original 3.5-order Fresnel lens, a maritime museum in the restored keeper's house, and is surrounded by scenic grounds. If you have time venture out to the point to search for Petoskey stones. After we break for lunch, we'll head to Tawas Point Lighthouse. It's a historic 1876 lighthouse featuring a 76-foot tower, 85-step climb (optional), and attached keeper's quarters. It offers panoramic Lake Huron views near the tip of Tawas Point State Park.
